While having students present at school is always our goal, there are times when staying home is in your child's, and everyone they come in contact with, best interest. Before sending your child to school, be sure that s/he is well enough to be in school. Do not assume your child will get better at school. With all the stimulation and exertion, students often decline while at school. Please understand we do not have a nurse staffed in the building to help with sick children. Our teachers are entitled to a duty-free lunch and cannot attend to children whose parents have requested they be kept inside. Only a physician or health care provider can request a temporary "staying in" from recess, unless it is mandated in the student's Health Care Plan.
